Orange County has approved additional restrictions for parking within the road right-of-way.

NEW STANDARDS & RESTRICTIONS

(Orange County Code Chapter 35. Traffic)

→ PROHIBITED PARKING & STORAGE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES IN ROW

- Commercial-use dual real wheel vehicles (\$150 parking fine)
- Vehicles with no license plate or current registration (\$30 parking fine subject to tow)
- Recreational vehicles (after 72 hrs)
 (\$30 parking fine)
- Trailers
 (\$30 parking fine)
- Vehicles under car covers
 (\$30 parking fine subject to tow)

VEHICLES CAUSING A SAFETY HAZARD

- Vehicles blocking visibility causing a safety hazard
 - (\$30 parking fine subject to tow)
- Vehicles blocking 20 ft clear access path for roads (fire / EMS access)
 (\$30 parking fine)
- Blocking mail delivery locations 8am 6pm (\$30 parking fine)
- Vehicles parking within 20 feet of mid-block crossings (\$30 parking fine)
- Vehicles on shared-use paths (\$30 parking fine)

VEHICLES IN PARKING SPACES

- Oversized vehicles using more than one marked parking space (\$30 parking fine)
- Parking non EV vehicles in EV parking spaces (\$30 parking fine)
