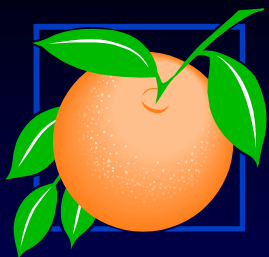


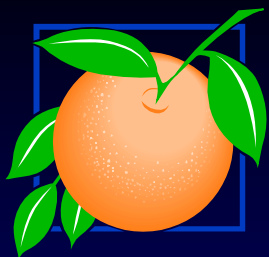

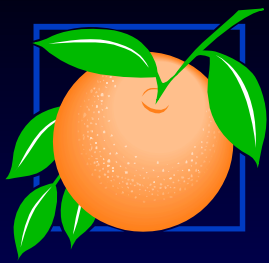
Improvements through District 2 Office

Improvements through District 2 Office

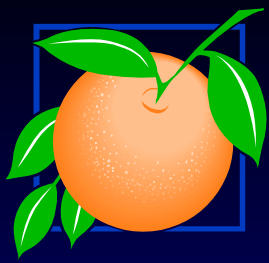
2. Traffic boxes painted with gray anti-graffiti coating throughout Lockhart
3. Many street light repairs – Cmsr. Moore's Staff worked with Duke Energy to get them all lit (for new lighting issues on main streets, call the district office; if within your subdivision, call 311. Good to conduct an audit every fall when the time changes.)



Improvements through District 2 Office

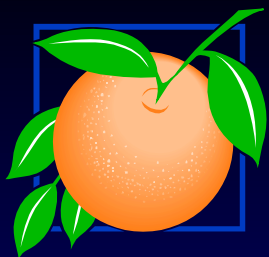
4. Major upgrade to Riverside Acres Park – benches and more trees – two pavilions still to be installed
 - The goal was to make this park better for senior citizens and families

5. Riverside Estates – new bench and trees along with \$1.7 million erosion control improvements along the river



Improvements through District 2 Office

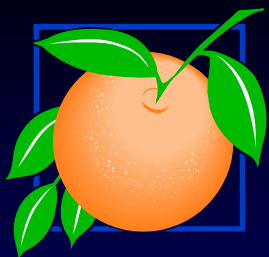
6. Many grass cutting calls to the state on US 441, and along Magnolia Homes

Improvements through District 2 Office

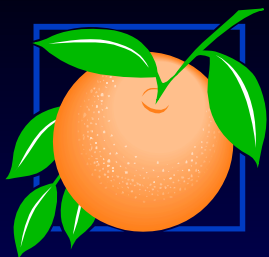
7. Much Code Enforcement work has been done along Edgewater Drive

 - Handles all individual complaints you may have; call 407.836.5850 or 407.836.5919



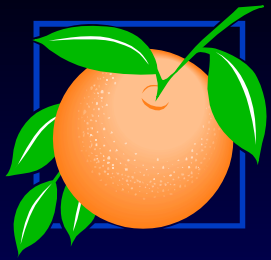
PLANNED or IN-PROCESS improvements

 - Ryan Wolfgang working on grants through Neighborhood Services



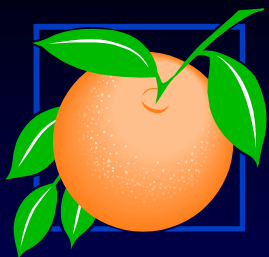
PLANNED or IN-PROCESS improvements

 - School crossing markings being added at Lockhart Elem. School
