- 1. Traffic signal boxes painted with anti-graffiti paint all along Clarcona-Ocoee Road
- 2. Trimmed many sections for trees/ grass along the corridors
  - Still a problem as county and state only mow 5-7 times per year; it is much better if HOAs cut Rights-of-Way or ROWs



#### Improvements through District 2 Office

- 3. Pressure-washed sidewalks & painted retaining wall at these locations
  - Clarcona-Ocoee and 441 in front of the CVS
  - Clarcona-Ocoee and Apopka-Vineland in front of the 7/11
  - GOAL: inspire better maintenance in these highly-visible commercial areas
- 4. Working with volunteers to pick up snipe signs all along this corridor; further south have the work of the NID, Safe Group, and Pine Hills Community Council



## Improvements through District 2 Office

- 5. Median beautification project from Hiawassee Rd. to SR 429 along Clarcona-Ocoee Rd.
- 6. Major cleanup of Clarcona-Ocoee/Apopka Vineland intersection



## PLANNED or IN-PROCESS improvements

- 1. Traffic signalization coming to Powers and Indian Hills Road in fall of 2021
- 2. Traffic signalization coming to Clarcona-Ocoee and Ingram Road fall of 2021 season



# PLANNED or IN-PROCESS improvements

- 3. Bus transfer station and trail improvements (Pine Hills Trail system & Coast to Coast)
- 4. **Big ASK**: All HOAs to consider pressure washing sidewalks and walls annually during the Fall season
