



## Repairs-Is A Permit Required For This Scope of Work?

It is important for you to always hire a State of Florida or Orange County licensed contractor for any repair work.

Here are a few things to remember:

Scope of Work Requiring a Permit	Scope of Work <b>Not</b> Requiring a Permit
Roof Repairs exceeding 100 sq. ft.	Roof Repairs not exceeding 100 sq. ft.
Electrical Repairs	Tree Trimming
Weather head Repair	Removal of Tree
Meter Base Repair	Removal of Debris
Window Replacement	Placing a Tarp on a Roof
Door Replacement	Rain gutter replacement
Drywall Replacement (check with the Building Division)	Replace screening on aluminum structures
Replacement of exterior siding	Repair of exterior soffit
All structural repairs
