Student Essay Word Counts:

High School: 500 Words or less

Middle School: 300 Words or less

Elementary School: 100 Words or less

•Poems must not exceed 30 lines.

•Entries may not contain any content that is obscene, offensive or endorses any form of hate or drug/alcohol use.

•All entries must be submitted as 8½ x 11

•All entries must include the student’s name, grade and school in top right corner of the essay/poem.

•Limit Five (5) entries per school.

Entries will be disqualified if contest rules are not followed.

Essays and Poems will be judged based on:

- Originality
- Creativity
- Neatness
- Clear presentation of topic
- Spelling/Grammar
- Following Contest Rules

Prizes will be awarded to:

1st, 2nd and 3rd Placings for Elementary Middle, and High School Students! Prizes will be delivered to each winners school front office.
