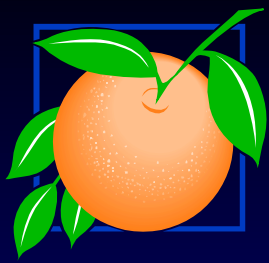


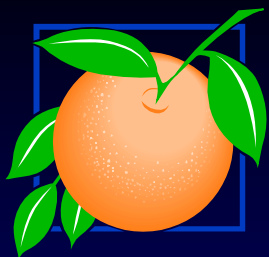

Improvements through District 2 Office

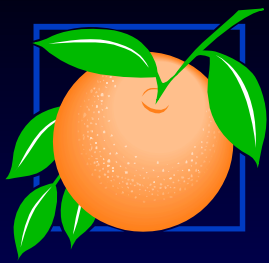
1. Major upgrades to roadways via traffic control mechanisms, county parks via new seating, pavilions, and Wi-Fi, and painting of traffic signal boxes at intersections
2. Many street light repairs – Cmsr. Moore's Staff worked with Duke Energy to get them lit (for new lighting issues on main streets, call the district office; if within your subdivision, call 311. Good to conduct an audit every fall when the time changes.)

3. Many grass cutting calls to the state along major highways
 - These entities only mow 5-7 times per year
 - This is why HOAs are preferable to get the work done more timely; budgets don't allow for more cuttings

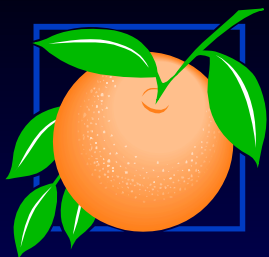
4. Walls and sidewalks/common areas
 - Now is the time to check – does your neighborhood wall and/or sidewalk, common area need a pressure-washing; how about painting of the wall?

5. Truck parking penalties increased to \$150
 - No tractor-trailer size trucks should be in neighborhoods or along Right-of-Ways (ROWs) – call 311 to report
