

Key Terms

- Key is to plant vegetation that likes amount of water
 - Obligate (OBL): Loves having their feet wet
 - Facultative Wet (FACW): Can survive in both wet conditions and dry conditions, but prefers wetter conditions.
 - Facultative (FAC): Can survive in both wet conditions and dry conditions, no preference.






