



Senior Climate Efficiency Program

Helping low-income seniors replace their aging HVAC systems

The Senior Climate Efficiency Program (SCEP) is designed to help low-income seniors (60+) in Orange County replace their home's worn or inoperative HVAC system. This service allows seniors to remain in their homes and age comfortably, while also lowering their utility bills.

Services

- HVAC system replacement:
 - HVAC system is more than 10 years old
 - Mismatched units (indoor and outdoor units are different makes or ages)
- Repair, service and clean if necessary/possible
 - Contractor must provide certificate of service
- Install smart thermostat with auto-function capability
- Install new A/C filter
- Additional energy efficiency services may be available to homeowners depending on home conditions and needs

Qualifications

- Must reside in Orange County
- Must be 60 years of age or older
- Maximum household income 200% of the Annual Federal Poverty Level

Required documents to apply

- Complete and signed SCEP Client Intake Form
- Must provide proof of home ownership
- Picture ID for **all** adult household members
- Current proof of income for **all** household members
- Copy of the last electric bill
- Other documents may be requested after application is reviewed
