Environmentally Responsible

U.S. Ambulance is minimizing the demand on natural resources and less of their waste is going to local landfills because of their increased recycling program. The company has an aggressive storm water protection program which moved away from using septic systems by connecting to municipal sanitary sewer and treatment systems. This reduces the amount of nutrients impacting ground water and nearby surface waters and leads to better water quality and cleaner drinking water resources. U.S. Ambulance Corporation is one of the nation's leaders in idle-reduction technology. Ambulances can sit idling for up to six hours a day waiting for their next call while burning fuel and generating toxic air emissions. The company took the initiative to run on electricity to power the air conditioning, radio, and other auxiliary features in between calls in order to reduce fuel consumption and air pollution.
