Mr. Williams had a question on parcel 26-22-32-0800-00-050 which did not appear on the OCPA website when conducting his research. Mr. Sladek did not have an issue with the parcel.

Applicant to strike parcel on the top of page 1 and page 10 (Exhibit B).

Chickasaw Creek Right-of-Way Agreement

Road Affected: Lake Underhill Road

Ms. Haslam provided an introduction and overview of the project.

The Committee commenced their review of the redline version of Chickasaw Creek Right-of-Way Agreement Page-by-Page:

Mr. Williams asked about Exhibit C and whether it is possible to resize the pond as necessary at a later date. Ms. Almodovar stated that she has worked with the applicant on the existing RCA Study and the calculations were performed to appropriately size the pond. Mr. Williams asked for the contingency language to be added in the event the pond size needed is larger. The Pond will serve the road only and project retention is contained elsewhere. Mr. Williams asked if the evaluation performed was a conservative approach. Mr. Baldocchi responded that he relied on the drainage basin from the RCA. Mr. Baldocchi calculated the depth of the pond greater than what the RCA proposed. Applicant is not constructing the pond - only dedicating fee simple land. Mr. Nastasi asked if there was a possibility that the County pond could pop off into the Developer's retention in the future. Mr. Williams asked if the fill slope easement could be expanded to include drainage to provide an area for further retention. PSP being scheduled to the BCC in November. Mr. Baldocchi stated the internal subdivision pond and the roadways will be County property moving forward.

The Committee asked the applicant to expand the Fill Slope Easement language to include Access and Drainage.

Specific changes to the agreement were discussed to page 3 lines 70-78. Ms. Haslam to redraft.

Page 3

• Line 79 subsection (b) should be (c) reorder this section and all the sections headings thereafter.

Page 4

• REM has confirmed the value of the appraisal. REM has reviewed the title work and there are several older encumbrances which need to be cleaned up.

Ms. Haslam to make the changes and send back to the Committee for Final Review.

Ms. Almodovar made a motion, with a second by Mr. Castillero, to approve the Chickasaw Creek Right-of-Way Agreement with changes discussed, subject to final review of exhibits by County Survey, subject to final review by the Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

Supplemental to Poinciana Boulevard Extension Agreement

Road Affected: Poinciana Boulevard

Mr. Abdallah provided an overview of separate meetings held with staff to discuss an alternate approach.

50% credits for Construction/Design is the alternate proposal and would still need an update to current draft.

Concern from Committee Members regarding the 2-lane construction into Osceola County which would not provide the 83.7% in excess capacity.

Ms. Almodovar stated that she had met with Mr. Paymayesh and would support 50% credits for Construction/Design along with the right-of-way dedication.

Mr. Nastasi stated three areas of concern:

- 1. 50% credits for Construction/Design.
- 2. Cost not yet finalized with Development Engineering
- 3. All signatories from the 1999 Agreement must agree to this proposal which does not require connection to this proposal which does not require connection to the North.

Mr. Williams stated this agreement does not alleviate traffic from SR 535 and would not support credits but will support credits provided for right-of-way.

Ms. Alfonso stated she had reviewed the Joinder language and suggested changes. She still needs to confirm all owners included in the new agreement and how to distinguish the condominium owners. Mr. Sladek stated that all owners are included as requested except for the condominium owners. A policy decision is needed for the condominium owners, and how to distinguish them in the legal language needed in the agreement. Perhaps an additional whereas clause to be included in the agreement.

- Enter the Parcel ID Numbers associated with the agreement
- Line 16 replace "Florida" with "Delaware"
- Lines 26-27 Countyline Properties is no longer active on Sunbiz, Owner to file updated report.

Page 2

- Mr. Abdallah stated only seeking 50% credits and not seeking anything more at a later date.
- Delete Whereas clause lines 50-52
- Update the defined term from "ROW" to "ROW&E"
- Lines 53-57 change "confirm the entitlements" to "address the award of transportation impact fee credits"

Page 3

- Line 65 add the word "are"
- Line 66 add the word "to"
- Update the Whereas Clause to include acknowledge, agree and confirm to match the joinder language.
- Lines 80-106 delete entirely
- Introduce concept of 50% credit for the project reflecting added capacity created for lanes 3 and 4

Page 4

- The Committee discussed Pond Capacity. There is sufficient capacity for roadway retention if the 2-lane section is widened in the future. The Committee asked to include a statement regarding available capacity in the agreement.
- Update all references of 83.7% to 50%.

Page 5

- Update costs and language in Section 4B
- The Committee questioned the word "cooperate" in line 115
- Line 116 remove landscaping requirement per Jennifer Cummings.

Page 7

- Line 181 replace "\$100,000" with "\$500,000"
- Line 169 subsection D may not be relevant but leave in the agreement

Page 9

• Right-of-Way to be conveyed at 100% credits for acreage provided.

• Section 8 needs to be updated.
