

# Potential Amenities

The Dog Park's program will include unstructured activities for both Dog and Parent.

## Examples of Potential Amenities:

- Group bench areas for dog and parent socializing
- Water fountains for dogs and parents
- Dog waste stations
- Trash and recycle receptacles
- Separate large and small dog areas
- Open space for unstructured dog play
- Natural shaded areas with benches for dogs and parents






# Potential Amenities Concept Plan

CYPRESS GROVE PARK




- 12' WIDE DOUBLE LEAVED MAINTENANCE GATES
- 6' HEIGHT BLACK VINYL CHAIN LINK FENCE, TOP AND BOTTOM RAILS
- BENCHES ON GROUP PAD
- NEW PET WASTE STATION, ONE STATION PER SIDE
- NEW WATER FOUNTAIN, WITH ADA BOWL AND PET BOWL EACH SIDE OF DOG PARK
- NEW DOG PARK ACCESS AREA WITH SEPARATE ENCLOSURES FOR SMALL AND LARGE DOGS
- NEW TRASH AND RECYCLE RECEPTACLES
- NEW CONCRETE ENTRY TRANSITION TO DOG PARK
- EXISTING CONCRETE WALKWAY TO REMAIN

- EXISTING PICKET FENCE AT PARK PERIMETER TO REMAIN
- EXISTING TREES TO REMAIN
- 12' WIDE DOUBLE LEAVED MAINTENANCE GATES
- SEPARATOR FENCING BETWEEN LARGE AND SMALL DOGS
- BENCHES ON GROUP PAD
- BENCH ON 8' X 5' CONCRETE PAD WITH ROUNDED CORNERS UNDER EXISTING TREES
- EXISTING TREES TO REMAIN
- NEW WALKWAY TO ACCESS GROUP BENCH AREA FOR ADA ACCESSIBILITY
- NEW LIVE OAK TREES
- 7' WIDE GATE FOR DOGS AND PARENTS
- EXISTING TREES TO REMAIN





Schedule is subject to change due to contractor schedules and supply chain deliveries. Construction budget is \$150,000


